



Standard Operating Procedures

COVID 19 – Screening for Non – RCMSAR Persons Entering RCMSAR Facility

Updated March 13, 2021

This SOP provides direction for personnel who are responsible for access to RCMSAR facilities/activities.

Step	Screening
1	<p>For station members responsible for non-RCMSAR personnel entering a station.</p> <p>Ask the person:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a. Are you feeling any flu-like symptoms (that are unusual in regards to seasonal allergies):<ul style="list-style-type: none">i. Coughii. Fever (over 38 degrees Celsius)iii. Difficulty Breathing/Shortness of Breathiv. Sneezingv. Sore scratchy throatb. Do you meet any of the following exposure criteria:<ul style="list-style-type: none">I. Traveled outside of Canada in the past 14 days.II. Close contact with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19 within 14 the past days.III. Close contact with a person who has travelled outside of Canada or has been asked by health authorities to self isolate in the past 14 days.IV. Been advised by health authorities to self isolate or monitor for symptoms
2	<p>If the answer is No to all of the above questions, allow the person to conduct business as usual.</p>
3	<p>If their answer is Yes to any of these questions do not allow the person access to the premises.</p>
4	<p>Advise them to contact HealthLink BC by dialling 8-1-1. A HealthLink BC nurse will provide advice on how to proceed with testing and/or treatment.</p>
