Subject: Illumination Flares

As part of last year's NIF equipment allocation, operational CCGA-P Units have received (or are about to receive) a limited number of illumination flares. Because these items are dangerous goods, distributing them has been a challenge, please bear with us if you have yet to receive yours.

When considering using these flares please consider the following:

- -These are **NOT** distress flares, they throw a white parachute flare intended for illumination during a SAR case.
- -Because of the limited number of these flares received, distributed and available, Units are requested to use them sparingly, and in situations where a brief supply of additional light over a large area during a SAR tasking would be beneficial. These flares should **NOT** be used for training or exercise purposes.
- -All CCGA-P units must discuss the potential use of the illumination flares with the JRCC **prior** to using them.
- -Units must ensure that no harm can come from the use of these flares (ensure that the area that the flare could drift into is safe).
- -Members who will be firing the flares must read, understand and comply with all the instructions printed on the flare bodies. Additionally, the members who have never fired a flare of any type, or have only ever fired distress flares, should expect and be prepared for a *significant* recoil.
- -Any Unit that has used these illumination flares during the course of a SAR tasking is requested to record the flare use in the significant events portion of the appropriate SAR Mission Report.
- -Any Unit that does use any of these flares during the next few months, is strongly encouraged to pass on a description of their experience in order that it can be shared with other which have not yet deployed the illumination flares themselves.
